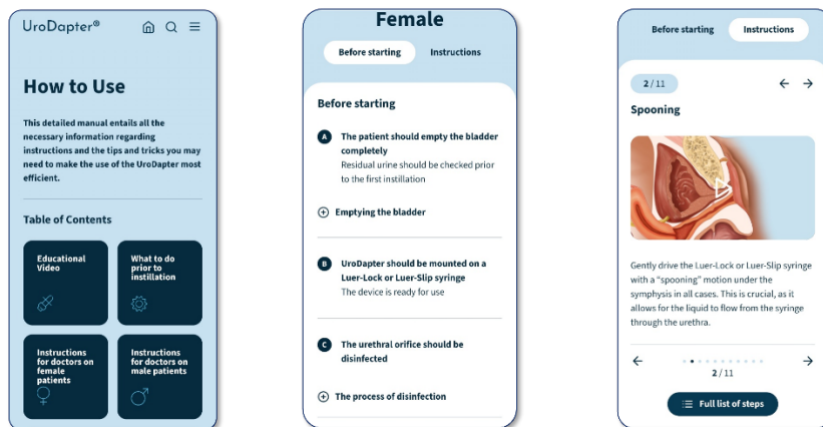

4. Available Publications

The available scientific publications can be found in this shared folder: [Publications](#)

Currently, there are three original retrospective studies published reporting on the safety and benefits of the UroDapter, and an ongoing prospective clinical trial. There are also two narrative reviews published in German language. The UroDapter is listed in the 2023. publication of the International Painful Bladder Foundation.

- **Lovasz, 2019:** In a 2019 prospective observational trial on the use of UroDapter in IC/BPS patients, the results of 1.520 instillations in 270 patients were reported. There were no infections or any other complications. The treatment was successful in 100% of male and 98% of female patients. The acceptance rate of UroDapter was 100%. All treated patients preferred the catheter-free method over conventional catheterization. None of them would ever consider being catheterized again.
- **Pothoven, 2023:** In a review about urinary tract infections, the authors also summarize the preliminary results of their study fully published in 2024.

- **Pothoven, 2024:** This retrospective study reports on the use of UroDapter in 61 patients with various bladder diseases: IC/BPS, overactive bladder, or recurrent urinary tract infections. The product name used in the publication is laludapter, which is another name for UroDapter, adjusted to fit the brand name of IBSA. There were no infections or other complications. Seventy-five percent of all patients and 82% of those over 50 years wanted to continue using the device, mainly because of the reduced pain, easy usage and the reduced risk of infections.
- **NOCATIN Study:** This is a multicentric prospective observational clinical trial evaluating the effectiveness, safety, and patient experience of the UroDapter. The study includes patients with IC/BPS, recurrent UTI, post-chemotherapy and post-radiation cystitis, and non-muscle invasive bladder cancer. The study protocol is [available](#) in the ClinicalTrials.gov database.
- **International Painful Bladder Foundation (IPBF), 2023:** The IPBF is one of the biggest international patient-initiated organization committed to deliver high quality information and help to IC/BPS patients worldwide, assisted by a panel of international medical experts. Their publication about the Diagnosis and Treatment of IC/BPS lists UroDapter as a novel catheter-free solution on page 30. The publication can be found in the shared folder or through this [link](#).
- **Global Consensus on IC/BPS 2025:** A global conference on IC/BPS was held in Winston-Salem, North Carolina, USA in April 2025 to establish expert consensus on the definition, diagnosis, classification, and treatment of IC/BPS. The aim of the meeting was to set new standards and disseminate them worldwide to improve patient care. The expert consensus paper recognizes UroDapter as a novel catheter-free instillation method, making instillations completely painless and treating the bladder and urethral symptoms simultaneously.
